Refer to the following information with regards to the homework for each day.

#### Monday

- Watch and listen to House for Sale Reading
- Complete 'Like and Do Not Like Worksheet'. The children should draw and label things that do and do not like, and complete two sentences at the bottom of the worksheet

### <u>Tuesday</u>

- Read House for Sale book (no need to print if you have the Green Level 1 Book at home) independently. If help is needed, watch the video again and follow along.
- Watch the House for Sale Flashcards Video
- Study the House for Sale Flashcards
- Complete yellow book homework words 'house' and 'stairs'
- [Optional: Print out two sets of the **House for Sale Flashcards**, cut out and play a matching game.]

## Wednesday

- Watch the Finding Materials Video
- Look at Finding Materials Diary Writing
- Children should search their own house for materials as seen in the video.
- Children should write sentences in their blue diary (or on the Blue Diary Writing Page) as they find materials (as shown in the video), using the Finding Materials Diary Writing as a guide. Children should also draw pictures in their diary of the materials they find.

#### **Thursday**

- Read House for Sale book (no need to print if you have the Green Level 1 Book at home) again. If help is needed, watch the video again and follow along.
- Complete House for Sale Comprehension Worksheet

• Complete yellow book homework words 'says' and 'it'

# Friday

- Look at the My Dream House Diary Writing example sentences
- Write sentences about the child's dream house in their blue diary (or on a copy
  of Blue Diary Writing Page). Use the noun and adjective boxes shown in My
  Dream House Diary Writing if needed.
- Use House for Sale Flashcards to help with ideas if needed.
